

## ATTORNEYS FEE SCHEDULE

Counsel appointed to represent a defendant in criminal proceedings, including a habeas corpus hearing, shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred with prior court approval for purposes of investigation and expert testimony, and shall be paid a reasonable attorney's fee for performing services as provided in Art. 26.05(a)(1), (2) and (3), Texas Code of Criminal Procedure based on the time and labor reasonably required, the complexity of the case, and the experience and ability of appointed counsel as follows:

In the following cases, for a plea agreement of guilty or true - \$300 plus \$50 for each additional case:

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In the following cases, for a plea agreement of guilty or true - \$250 plus \$50 for each additional case:

Additional services:

1. In-court time and work: \$50 - \$100 per hour
2. Out-of-court time and work \$50 - \$80 per hour
