

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS ADJOURNING THE PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENTS TO BE LEVIED AGAINST THE ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CROSSINGS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND CONTINUING THE HEARING AT A LATER DATE; AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court (the *Commissioners Court*) of Comal County, Texas (the *County*) previously published a notice of public hearing to consider proposed assessments to be levied against the assessable property within the Crossings Public Improvements District (the *District*) pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 371, as amended, of the Texas Local Government Code (the *Act*);

WHEREAS, this notice disclosed that the Commissioners Court intended to meet on May 26, 2016;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the owners of property liable for assessment to adjourn the public hearing and continue the public hearing at a later date; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Commissioners Court hereby determines that it will adjourn and continue, until June __, 2016, the public hearing to consider proposed assessments to be levied against the assessable property within the District pursuant to the provisions of the Act.

SECTION 2: The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Commissioners Court.

SECTION 3: All orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

SECTION 5: If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the

Commissioners Court hereby declares that this Resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 6: It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

SECTION 7: This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its adoption, and it is so resolved.
