ORDER GRANTING DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 262.023 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES


WHEREAS, Section 262.023 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the Commissioners Court to comply with competitive procurement procedures for purchase of one or more items under a contract that will require an expenditure exceeding \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 262.024(a)(4) of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to grant an exemption for "a personal or professional service"; and

WHEREAS, Comal County wishes to procure professional services from Brinkley Sargent Wiginton Architects for Professional Architectural Services for a Sheriff's Office and Jail Study.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FOR COMAL COUNTY THAT: The provisions of Texas Local Government Code §262.024(a)(4) shall apply to exempt the procurement of professional services with **Brinkley Sargent Wiginton Architects** for the Development of Design and Budget for Building a New Jail and Expanding the Sheriff's Office into the Existing Jail from the competitive procurement procedures because it qualifies as a professional service pursuant to Texas Government Code 2254.002(D)(2)(b) .
