Directors appointed to new Groundwater Conservation District

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County commissioners on Thursday approved seven appointments to the Comal Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.

The directors will be responsible for establishing a conservation plan for the Trinity Aquifer in Comal County and regulating the wells that tap into it. They are:

- **Larry Hull**, Spring Branch-area rancher, nominated by Precinct 1 Commissioner Donna Eccleston.
- **Jim Bower**, rancher and Garden Ridge resident, nominated by Precinct 2 Commissioner Scott Haag.
- **Clinton Dietert**, farmer/rancher who lives near New Braunfels, nominated by Precinct 3 Commissioner Kevin Webb.
- **H.L. Saur**, retired water-well driller from Spring Branch, nominated by Precinct 4 Commissioner Jen Crownover.
- **Larry Sunn**, CEO of the software development company Tidua and Bulverde resident, nominated by County Judge Sherman Krause.
- **David Davenport**, general manager of Canyon Regional Water Authority and New Braunfels resident, and **Robert Johnson**, partner of the law firm bearing his name, nominated by the Commissioners Court as a whole.

“Today’s appointments are the culmination of a long and careful process that will help ensure the long-term viability of groundwater in Comal County,” said Precinct 2 Commissioner Scott Haag. “I congratulate the new directors and look forward to working with them in the weeks and months ahead.”
