Ribbon-cutting to open newest county park near Bulverde

MEDIA ADVISORY, OCTOBER 26, 2015:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Media are invited to attend as Comal County and Bulverde officials will celebrate the opening of Kleck Park at 9:30 a.m. this Friday, Oct. 30, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony.

The 43-acre, heavily wooded park features 1.2 miles of trails for hiking, biking and even horse-riding. Land for the park was deeded to the county by the Helen Kleck Vivian Living Trust in 2014. The park also includes 16 marked and numbered birdhouses.

The Commissioners Court approved a \$14,000 contract to cut trails through the park in August; work was completed in early October. Kleck joins the Curry Nature Center, Jumbo Evans Sports Center and Hidden Valley Sports Park as Comal County-owned parks and recreation areas.

Kleck Park is located [east of Bulverde](#) on Stahl Lane, about 1.5 miles north of FM 1863. Because of limited parking, the ribbon-cutting is not open to the general public, and attendees are advised to car-pool to the event if at all possible.
