Comal County issues disaster declaration

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, OCTOBER 30, 2015:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County has declared a local state of disaster as the result of flooding that remains ongoing.

The county “has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property ... resulting from disastrous flooding and flash flooding,” according to the declaration. A copy of the declaration is attached.

The proclamation takes effect immediately. Along with flooding reported from Bulverde and Spring Branch earlier this morning, the county has sounded its flood-alert sirens on River Road between Canyon Lake and New Braunfels, and the National Weather Service forecasts significant flooding along the Guadalupe River before it crests at over 25 feet this afternoon.

Likewise, many roads across the county are littered with debris caused by previous flooding. Residents are asked to stay off the roads if at all possible, and to exercise caution if they are driving today.
