Early voting for Nov. 3 election begins Monday

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, OCTOBER 15, 2015:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Early voting begins Monday for the Nov. 3 election, which will include seven proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution, a proposed \$76 million bond issue for a new Comal County jail, a proposed \$62.8 million bond issue for New Braunfels Independent School District and the proposed incorporation of the City of Spring Branch.

Monday also will mark the first use of new voting machines in Comal County since 2004. While the seven constitutional amendment propositions and the jail bond will be on all Comal County ballots, other measures will depend on the voter's residence.

“Although people don't tend to get as excited for ballot-issue elections as they do for presidential or gubernatorial races, this is still an important election that will decide how your tax dollars are spent for years to come,” said Elections Administrator Cynthia Jaqua (JAY-quay). “We encourage everyone who is registered to come out and vote early.”

Unlike on Election Day, registered voters can cast their ballot upon showing an acceptable photo ID at any polling place in the county, regardless of whether it is in the voter's polling precinct. Early voting ends Friday, Oct. 30; Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 3.

- Saturday, Oct. 24, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- Sunday, Oct. 25, 1-6 p.m.
- Monday-Friday, Oct. 26-30, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.,
 - Except at Garden Ridge City Hall on Tuesday, Oct. 27 (7 a.m. – 4 p.m.)
