County to provide tax incentives for CTG plant

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, DECEMBER 22, 2015:

NEW BRAUNFELS — The Comal County Commissioners Court this morning approved a tax incentive for Canadian General Tower (CGT) that will provide a 60 percent rebate of county property taxes for 10 years.

The rebate is contingent on CGT relocating to New Braunfels, investing \$50 million in capital improvements and creating 150 jobs by Jan. 1, 2019, and maintaining those investments through the life of the agreement.

CGT, which is based in Cambridge, Ontario, manufactures coated films and fabrics, such as pool liners, automobile dashboards, and roofing and decking products. Its New Braunfels manufacturing plant would be the first tenant in the new Titan industrial park on FM 1101.

“CGT is going to be a great partner and corporate citizen in Comal County,” said County Judge Sherman Krause. “We look forward to working with them.”
