Registration card error will not affect residents' ability to vote

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, DECEMBER 28, 2015:

NEW BRAUNFELS — A printing error on the first batch of voter registration cards sent to Comal County residents late last week will not affect voters' ability to vote in primary elections this spring, said county Elections Coordinator Cynthia Jaqua.

Voters' first and middle or maiden names were transposed on the cards sent last week. The names remain correct on the county's rolls, which are checked against the photo ID voters must present at the polling place.

The Comal County Elections Office also plans to send new cards with corrected names, Jaqua said.

"It's an unfortunate error, and we apologize for any concern or confusion it caused," she said, "but no one will be turned away from voting because of it."
