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County property taxes due Monday

NEW BRAUNFELS — With the annual Jan. 31 deadline for paying property taxes falling on a Sunday this year, Comal County property owners have an extra day to settle their accounts with the county Tax Office.

The office, 205 N. Seguin Ave., will be open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday, Jan. 29, and 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday, Feb. 1. Branch offices in Sattler (160 Oak Drive) and Bulverde (30450 Cougar Bend) will be open until 4:30 p.m. both days. The New Braunfels and Sattler locations have secure drop-off boxes, as does the City of Garden Ridge municipal parking lot.

“We’re working hard to make the experience as quick and painless as possible,” said Cathy Talcott, county tax assessor-collector, “and I encourage everyone to come in as early as possible to avoid waiting in line.”

Residents have several payment options for their property taxes: cash, check, money order or cashier’s check in person; and credit/debit card or echecks (includes a fee required by the vendor) online at comalcountytaxoffice.net, by phone at 866-550-0031 or by scanning the QR code on the statement.

Residents also can view and print statements and receipts from the website. To get a receipt with a mailed-in or dropped-off payment, include a self-addressed stamped envelope.

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
