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Clerk's Office now accepts electronic filing of land records

NEW BRAUNFELS — The Comal County Clerk's Office today began accepting electronic filing of deeds, liens, affidavits and other land records.

The office had required that the documents, usually filed by title companies, be recorded by mail or in person at the office, on the first floor of the Comal County Courthouse Annex, 150 N. Seguin Ave. After months of software work and a week of testing, electronic filing went live this morning, said County Clerk Bobbie Koepp.

"We're excited about this new chapter in customer service for our office," Koepp said. "This will make it more convenient for those doing business with the County Clerk's Office, and the reduction in paper will save money and be friendlier for the environment."

The change will affect about 1,200 documents per week filed with the office. Plats still must be filed in person.

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
