Flood siren testing schedule finalized

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, MARCH 10, 2016:

SATTLER — The Water Oriented Recreation District (WORD) has set a testing schedule for flood sirens along the Guadalupe River in Comal County.

Five large-scale tempest sirens and three location-specific sirens will be tested monthly beginning April 12, followed by the first Tuesday of each month, between 10 and 11 a.m.

Each siren will sound for up to 4 minutes, although the duration will be truncated whenever possible. Testing will not be conducted during an active rain event.

The locations of the sirens are:

- FM 306 Guadalupe River bridge
- 4th crossing bridge on River Road
- 3rd crossing bridge on River Road
- 2nd crossing bridge on River Road
- 1st crossing bridge on River Road
- Nichol's Landing on Old Spring Branch Road
- U.S. 281 Guadalupe River bridge
- FM 311 just upstream of the Guadalupe River

“We are thrilled that the western sites are complete, and that the entire flood warning system is up and running,” said Mike Dussere, WORD general manager. “This testing schedule will allow crews to ensure that the system is operational and ready to give notice in the event of an emergency.”
