**Commissioners Court approves revamped Adopt-a-Road program**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, MARCH 31, 2016:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS* — The Comal County Commissioners Court this morning revamped the county’s dormant Adopt-a-Road program – putting in place a system that also allows for one-time roadway cleanups.

The Adopt-a-Road program began in the 1980s but hasn’t seen participation for several years. The new program makes county commissioners, instead of the Road and Bridge Department, the contact points for those seeking to adopt stretches of county-maintained roadways. Commissioners will determine which segments of road are eligible for adoption and coordinate that adoption with interested residents.

Once determined, roadways eligible for adoption will be posted on the Comal County Engineer’s Office website, [cceo.org](http://cceo.org).

In addition, a new program called Clean Sweep provides a way for residents to clean up the right-of-way on a road or in a subdivision as a one-time project, also facilitated through their commissioner.

Precinct 4 Commissioner Jen Crownover said she worked with Hornseth to revive the adoption program after receiving a request from a constituent. The programs were approved on a 5-0 vote.

“These programs are a great way to help our residents who want to keep Comal County beautiful do so safely,” Crownover said. “Whether they want to take care of a roadway on an ongoing basis or do a one-time cleanup, we now have a program in place to help them do that.”
