Monday is voter registration deadline for May 24 primary runoff

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 22, 2016:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County voters wishing to cast a ballot in the May 24 primary runoff election must register to vote by Monday.

Those who have not yet registered to vote can do so in person at the Comal County Elections Office, 178 E. Mill St., Suite 100, or they can print and mail the application on the Elections Office webpage. Applications must be postmarked by the Monday, April 26, deadline.

The May 24 primary runoff comprises contested elections for state railroad commissioner on both the Republican and Democratic sides. Contested races on the GOP side include county sheriff, Dist. 73 state representative and one place on the state Court of Criminal Appeals.

Early voting for the election begins May 16 and ends May 20.

Those who are registered and did not vote in the March 1 primary election can vote in either party's runoff election; those who voted in a party's election on March 1 can only vote in the same party's runoff.
