Lunch-and-learn focuses on HOA/POA issues

NEW BRAUNFELS — Board members of homeowners' and property owners' associations and other interested Comal County residents are invited to attend a lunch-and-learn event about the interaction between communities and county government.

The event is hosted by Precinct 4 Commissioner Jen Crownover, and will occur from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Friday, Oct. 21, at Tye Preston Memorial Library in Canyon Lake.

“As the population grows in the unincorporated areas of Comal County, we are getting more and more questions about what county government does and how POAs and HOAs play into regulating communities,” Crownover said. “I hope this lunch-and-learn will help clarify the different roles we have as county government, HOA and POA board members, and neighbors.”

The Community Association Institute will present information and conduct a question-and-answer session. The panel of speakers also will include county representatives, who will provide information about law and code enforcement, roads and other areas under the county's purview.
