County honors Holder, Miller with keys to Courthouse

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County honored a pair of public servants on Thursday, presenting outgoing Sheriff Bob Holder and state Rep. Doug Miller each with a Key to the Courthouse for their years of service to the county's residents.

The Commissioner Jan Kennady Key to the Courthouse is the county's highest honor. Holder and Miller are deserving of the recognition, said County Judge Sherman Krause.

Keys are awarded to those who have made significant contributions to "preserving the rich history and quality of life in Comal County."

"These officials have dedicated their lives to serving the county and its residents," Krause said. "We thank them for their service, and we are proud to honor them this way."

Holder has served Comal County in law enforcement since 1977, winning election as sheriff in 1996. His 20 years marks the second-longest tenure of any Comal County sheriff.

"I am amazed," he said upon receiving his key. "I'm so honored with this. I never dreamed that this would occur. I'm very humbled by this and sincerely appreciate it."

Miller, a former New Braunfels mayor and city councilman, has represented District 73 in the Texas House of Representatives for four terms.

"It has been a real honor and privilege and a pleasure," he said. "As mayor, I gave out a lot of keys to the city, but I never got one."
