WHEREAS, New Braunfels Garden Club is recognized and appreciated as a strong advocate for the promotion of a balanced and productive ecology; and


WHEREAS, The Members of New Braunfels Garden Club continue to work to learn the latest gardening techniques and to inform others about the benefits of gardening; and
