Naming the week of May 5, 2013 through May 11, 2013 as "NATIONAL CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES WEEK IN COMAL COUNTY"

WHEREAS, National Correctional Officers and Employees Week was first proclaimed on May 5, 1984 by President Ronald Reagan when he signed Proclamation 5187 creating "National Correctional Officers' Week", to recognize the men and women who work in jails, prisons, and community corrections across the county; and

WHEREAS, National Correctional Officers and Employees Week became the official name the first week in May when, in 1986, the U.S. Senate officially changed the name from "National Correctional Officers' Week"; and

WHEREAS, National Correctional Officers and Employees Week has been designated as the week of May 5, 2013 through May 11, 2013 by the U.S. Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Prisons; and


WHEREAS, National Correction Officers and Employee Week honors the work of correctional officers and correctional personnel for their service with honor, respect and integrity; and

WHEREAS, National Correctional Officers and Employees Week raises awareness of the duties, hazards and sacrifices made by the Correctional Workers; and


