



Proclamation

Naming the Month of April 2013 as "Sexual Assault Awareness Month"

WHEREAS, sexual assault is one of the most violent and devastating crimes in society today, impacting the lives of men, women, and children of all racial, cultural, and economic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, there are many types of sexual assault, including verbal harassment and intimidation, molestation, rape, and pornography; and

WHEREAS, sexual assault goes unreported far too often, and leaves long-lasting physical and emotional scars; and

WHEREAS, sexual violence is preventable and speaking out against sexual assault is an important first step. We must work together to educate our entire population about what can be done to eradicate and prevent sexual assault and to support survivors, to ensure that they are given the help that they need to take back control and ensure that they are not re-victimized; and






