Comal County, Texas

Comal County was established by the First Legislature of the State of Texas in 1846. After meeting in several different locations, the county commissioned its current courthouse designed by famed courthouse architect J. Reilly Gordon. The Comal County Courthouse was completed in 1898, dedicated on January 22, 1899, and has served as the center of county government for more than 100 years.

Over those years, the courthouse fell into a state of disrepair, and in 2003 Commissioner Jan Kennady championed an effort to preserve Comal County history by restoring the courthouse to its original glory. The restoration was completed and marked with a rededication ceremony on January 22, 2013. The Comal County Courthouse again stands as a picturesque symbol of Comal County's heritage.

In accepting this Key to the Courthouse, the recipient agrees to be a member of the noble Corps of Distinguished Keyholders, and further agrees to continue the ongoing work of preserving the rich history and quality of life in Comal County.
