RECOGNIZING THE COMAL COUNTY HISTORICAL COMMISSION WITH THE TEXAS HISTORICAL COMMISSION'S *2013 DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD*

Whereas, The Comal County Historical Commission has accomplished substantial preservation work that celebrates the role of history in our lives and acknowledges with thanksgiving the outstanding contributions made by those who came before us; and

Whereas, The efforts of the Commission members emphasize stewardship of our cultural and historic resources, encourage economic development, and generate interest in the history and character of our county; and

Whereas, The Comal County Historical Commission has participated in effective partnerships with the Comal County Genealogical Society, Comal County Commissioners Court, City of New Braunfels, Landmark Commission, Greater New Braunfels Chamber of Commerce, Sophienburg Museum and Archives, Conservation Society, Comal Settlement Association, Schertz Historical Preservation Committee, New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, Wurstfest Association and individuals or groups seeking historical markers; and

Whereas, The Comal County Historical Commission devoted 1696 hours in the year 2013 to important projects such as historical research for the Texas Historical Commission marker program, Comal County marker dedications, providing over 90 docents for the courthouse celebration, providing courthouse tours to 700+ second graders, helping with the courthouse time capsule project, completing the survey of three-fourths of the county, beginning the survey of the remaining one-fourth of the county and financing of the scanning the earliest county voting records from 1848; and

Whereas, The education of current and future generations will continue to be enhanced through the identification and preservation of the County's historic resources with relevant information in the media, on the county website and other communication avenues available to the Historical Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Comal County Commissioners Court does hereby gratefully honor and congratulate the Comal County Historical Commission for receiving the 2013 Distinguished Service Award by the Texas Historical Commission, and invites all citizens of Comal County to recognize the members of this Commission for their extraordinary accomplishments.




