RECOGNIZING RONALD B. SNIDER, RECIPIENT OF THE FREDERICK FRUEHOLZ, JR. HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARD

WHEREAS, the Comal County Historical Commission has designated the Frederick Frueholz Jr. Historic Preservation Award in honor of Dr. Frederick Frueholz Jr., a long-time member of the Comal County Historical Commission and the first chairman; and

WHEREAS, one recipient will be chosen annually by Comal County Historical Commission members and the award presented in May of each year to celebrate Texas Historic Preservation Month; and


WHEREAS, the recipient shall be chosen based on their dedication to historical preservation of Comal County; and

WHEREAS, Ronald B. Snider, has a long history of preservation in downtown New Braunfels. He recognized potential in buildings in the downtown area almost twenty years ago and has restored several structures with the help of Darrell Sollberger and Dr. Frank Hampel. While many other downtowns have languished, Ron has done much to help make downtown New Braunfels an active, productive, bustling area and keep the old-time atmosphere that appeals to locals and visitors alike. The properties include the Seekatz Opera House at 265 W. San Antonio St., renovated over a seven year period; the 1910 Richter Building at 142 W. San Antonio St.; the 1920 Richter Building at 168 W. San Antonio St.; the 1938 Palace Theater that is Myron's Steak House and the Blue Artichoke; the 1910 Hinman Café at 277 W. San Antonio St; and the Herald Zeitung-KGNB Building at 188 S. Castell that houses the restaurants 188 South and Blue Moose Pizza as well as the Farmers Market offices.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Comal County Commissioners Court duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, and the Comal County Historical Commission wish to commend you on your work towards receiving this award and your dedication to historical preservation and recording the history of Comal County.
