WHEREAS, The Comal County Historical Commission has accomplished substantial preservation work that celebrates the role of history in our lives and acknowledges with thanksgiving the outstanding contributions made by those who came before us – its members emphasizing stewardship of our cultural and historical resources, encouraging economic development, and generating interest in the history and character of our county; and


WHEREAS, The Comal County Historical Commission has participated in effective partnerships with the Comal County Commissioners Court, New Braunfels Historic Landmark Commission, Sophienburg Museum and Archives, New Braunfels Department of Parks and Recreation, Fischer Agricultural Society, Fischer Store School Community Association, New Braunfels Conservation Society, Germania Farmer Verein, and the Texas Historical Commission; has assisted in designations and marker research for Fischer Historic District, Slumber Falls Youth Camp, Phoenix Saloon, Comal Steam Laundry, 1915 Post Office, New Braunfels Methodist Church, Comal County Fair, Anhalt Halle, Walzem Chapel, Windwehen House, Arnold-Rauch-Brandt Homestead, West End Hall, Mill Street Telegraph Office, Fischer Store, Fischer Agricultural Society, Black Whale Pub, and the German Pioneers in Texas; has awarded the second annual Frederick Frueholz Preservation Award to Ron Snider; and has provided funding to scan the Morales Funeral Home records; and

WHEREAS, The Comal County Historical Commission devoted numerous hours in 2015 to important projects such as obtaining a grant for preparing the nomination of Fischer Historic District to the National Register of Historic Places; coordinating and managing the Texas Historical Commission Marker Program, which includes restoration of existing markers; the Texas Treasure Business Award; and Section 106 Project Review; and

WHEREAS, the education of current and future generations will continue to be enhanced through the identification and preservation of the County's historic resources with relevant information published in the news media, on the county website and through other communication avenues available to the Historical Commission.


